But Mark was lazy, too!

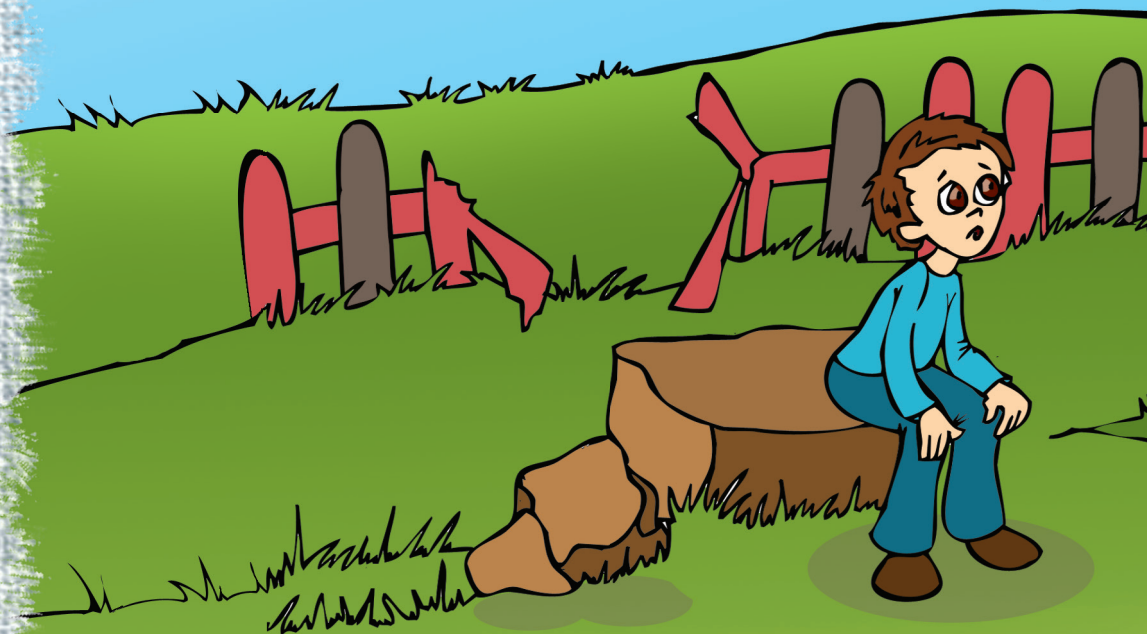


Jack and Mark were happy.

But Bill was careless!

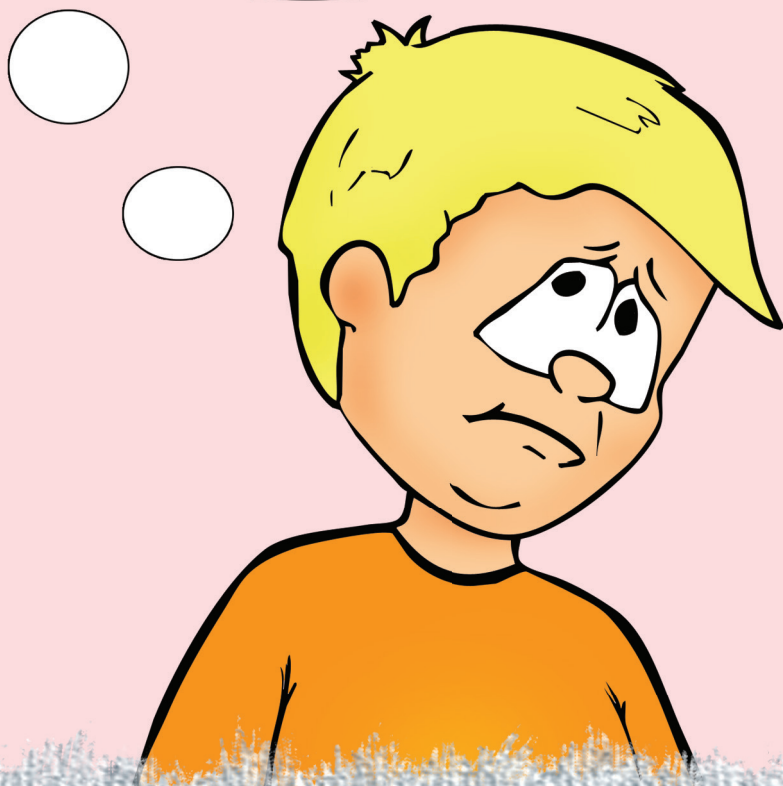
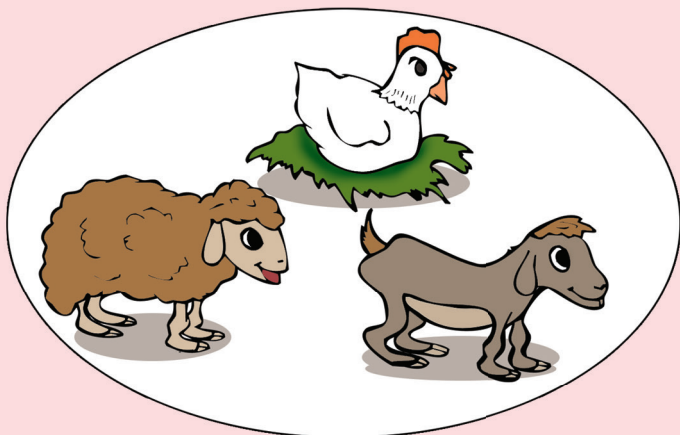




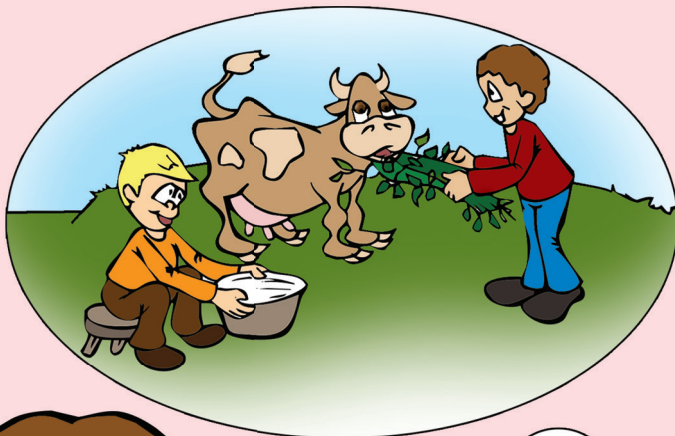
Jack said to Bill,
